

PRINCE2® Foundation project management

Content

PRINCE2 (Projects IN Controlled Environments) is a process-based approach for project management. This project management tool provides an easily tailored and scalable method for the management of all types of projects. The method is developed by the British government and is nowadays practiced worldwide in more than 125 countries. PRINCE2 is developed with the experience of many years of seasoned project managers.

PRINCE2 provides you the structure that proves to be essential to manage projects successfully. With PRINCE2 you can deliver the project's product within time and budget. PRINCE2 can be used in a profit environment and also in a not-for profit environment.

The foundation level provides you with the basic knowledge and understanding of the PRINCE2 method. You will be able to work effectively in a project management team working in an environment supporting PRINCE2. The PRINCE2 Foundation certificate is recognized worldwide.

The PRINCE2 Foundation qualification is aimed at project managers and aspiring project managers. It is also relevant to other key staff involved in the design, development and delivery of projects, including: Project Board members (e.g. Senior Responsible Owners), Team Managers (e.g. Product Delivery Managers), Project Assurance (e.g. Business Change Analysts), Project Support (e.g. Project and Programme Office personnel) and operational line managers/staff.

The course

This course is a very intense 3 full days of training. There is also some evening homework required to be done estimated at about 1- 1,5 hours per evening. Before the start of the course you will receive a pre-course reader to read. Some experience in projectwork is recommended.

The PRINCE2 Foundation exam is included.

The course will address the following main topics:

- The characteristics and context of a project and the benefits of adopting PRINCE2
- The purpose of the PRINCE2 roles, management products and themes
- The PRINCE2 principles
- The purpose, objectives and context of the PRINCE2 processes.

Foundation Examination

The purpose of the foundation qualification is to confirm you have sufficient knowledge and understanding of the PRINCE2 method to be able to work effectively with, or as a member of, a project management team working within an environment supporting PRINCE2. The foundation qualification is also a pre-requisite for the practitioner qualification.

The exam:

- Multiple choice format
- 75 questions per paper

- 5 questions to be trial and not counted in scores
- 35 marks required (out of 70 available) to pass - 50%
- Closed book.

The examination will cover all 15 areas of the PRINCE2 Foundation syllabus. The full PRINCE2 syllabus is available from the APM Group or from your Accredited Training Organisation Smart Solutions.
